

LEAGUE AND DIVISIONAL MEETS

If you are HOSTING THE MEET, score sheets/score keeping are provided by the league. You supply a STARTER, CLERK OF THE COURSE and FINISH LINE RECORDERS.

If you are working a FIELD EVENT, scoring paperwork will be provided. You will need the following:

LONG JUMP	BROOM, RAKE, 25' MEASURING TAPE
HIGH JUMP	BROOM, 6' MEASURING TAPE
SHOT PUT	BROOM, 50' MEASURING TAPE

EACH SCHOOL WILL PROVIDE TIMERS AND LANE JUDGES.

Inform you timers that they are not to time the lanes....TIME THE PLACES!

While times are great, it is the PLACES that are most important.

FOR THE CLERK OF THE COURSE:

Group the running athletes in advance of events so that they can be set up in their lanes. Make sure that the high jump starts on time and stays on schedule. Athletes in the field events have 1-1/2 minutes to complete a jump or put after their name is called.

If heats are run, only the first heat is scored. In this case, each school is responsible for placing their best athletes in the first heat.

Coaches are responsible for being at the league meets early enough to review/correct the event cards and turn in their meet rosters.

Athletes will be given ONE false start, the second is a disqualification.

If a meet runs ahead of schedule, events will not be held up waiting for an athlete to show. It is the responsibility of coaches and athletes to make sure that they are present at the start of an event.
