

PPSL Basketball Meeting
November 6, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 7:16 pm
Roll was taken. All school Commissioners present.
Ellie passed around the 2013 Basketball commissioner roster and asked for corrections or additions.

Ellie thanked the Athletic Directors from Nativity, St. Pius and OLA for hosting the recent volleyball playoff games.

Ellie introduced the Basketball commissioners for the league:
Mike Watkins, Dominic Franco, Darrell Cullen and Deborah Cullen
Reminding commissioners that weekly scores, player absent and pull up's must be sent to both the North and South commissioners.

Discussion was held asking all present what their thoughts were to changing the 7th and 8th grade teams to division scheduling for the 2013 season.
A vote was taken on this recommendation and passed 13-yes 3-no.
The league basketball commissioners and Ellie will meet to decide on dividing the teams and a playoff format for the JV/Varsity Divisions 1, 2, 3.

Ellie will send out an updated basketball roster that will list divisions 1, 2 and 3.
Ellie asked if possible to list all the school's teams on one page, it's ok to change the names listed on the rosters to match their team names.
Another request, when completing your team rosters, next to the names of your Varsity players, list their size. This will help when selecting T-Shirts for the varsity players who will compete in the final championship games.
(Adult sizes SM, Med, LG, XL, XXL, etc.).

The 2013 basketball rosters must be sent to Ellie by December 10th. You may scan your rosters but the original copy must be mailed to Ellie. All valid rosters must be signed by both the pastor and principal. All coaches listed on your team rosters must be compliant prior to coaching or practicing with any team.

Ellie introduced both ref assignors for the league; North assignor, Dino Skoufis and South assignor, Tony Escobar. Dino Skoufis informed the league commissioners that there are no new rule changes for the 2013 season. The two assignors gave their phone numbers and informed the commissioners to call them a.s.a.p. if a referee is a no show, and to follow up with a phone call when the referee does show up...

Ellie spoke about upcoming basketball tournaments.
Notre Dame (7th and 8th grade girls)...December 14-16
OLA (6th girls)...December 14-16
St Charles (4th-8th boys)...November 30-December 21

Nothing But Hoops, (PPSL 5th girls)...December 14-16
Ray Harold (Boys and Girls Varsity)...December 7th, 8th & 9th.

Cheryl will email to all commissioners information regarding "Who is in what division", Commissioners need to respond back to Cheryl that the information listed on this form is correct.

Next you will receive the **2013 Draft Schedule**; Cheryl explained to all commissioners how to check for errors on the schedule.

Cheryl's reminders when receiving the draft schedule:

- 1- It is each school's responsibility to check for errors, to verify that all the teams you submitted are listed, that the dates, times and locations are correct.
- 2- Verify that a team is not scheduled to play twice on the same day, in some cases, Cheryl schedules teams to play on two consecutive days, if this is a problem it's up to you to find an alternate date for one of your games.
- 3- TBA's on your schedule, it's each home team's commissioner's responsibility to find a location, date and time to schedule any game(s) that are listed as a TBA. (You do not need to get approval from the visiting team when scheduling a date for your TBA).
- 4- When you receive the Draft schedule, you will receive a final date that's required for all to send back any changes and or corrections. If your schedule is correct and you don't have any corrections or changes, send Cheryl a response back that your team schedule is correct.
- 5- After the deadline date, Cheryl will send out the **FINAL SCHEDULE**, at this time Cheryl's job is over, any additional problems with your schedule must go through your commissioner and or me.

One exception was requested by St Dunstan's girls division:

That their 6th grade & two 7th grade girls play in the 6th Lions division, reason, last year they did not sponsor a 5th grade team, the two 5th grade girls were given an exception to play on the 4th training team. Passed 16 yes 0 no.
